
1. Rio Tinto Alcan would like to conduct an underwater inspection of the Skins Lake Spillway plunge pool. The inspection will provide the required information to plan for further repairs to both the apron and plunge pool. In order to conduct this underwater inspection SLS discharge will need to be lowered to 14.2 m³/s for a period of 3-4 hours. This decrease in discharge will not result in any change to discharge at Cheslatta Falls and will be accounted for in the annual flow allocation.
2. The Technical Committee has considered this request in the context of the NFCP mandate and does not have an objection to this request.
