Modified Scheduling of Residency Study

The current NFCP 5-Year Plan called for a Residence Time study in 2013. This study was deferred until 2014, as reflected by Decision Record 2012/2013-1. Based on unanimous agreement by the Steering Committee, this study has been further deferred until 2015. The impact of this shift will include rescheduling of the fry emergence and juvenile chinook outmigration program during 2016-2017.
